

Remodeling of Granada Will Begin Dec. 20

Work of tearing out the equipment in the Granada theatre to make way for the remodeling of the building into a department store by the W. T. Grant and company will start December 20, according to W. B. Shuttee, manager of the theatre. The showhouse will close following the last show December 19.

The Granada ballroom will continue to operate, according to Ed W. Stoker, manager. He said a new entrance will be built shortly after January 1, direct from Main street, north of the present theatre lobby.

The showhouse was first opened about fifteen years ago under the name of the American. It was remodeled eight months ago at a cost of \$50,000, and soon after the lease and building was purchased by the W. T. Grant company, for a figure said to have been more than \$600,000.
