

### The Lyceum Is Rechristened.

There was a quiet christening in Salt Lake yesterday which was not known until Willard Mack announced it in a curtain talk at the Colonial theater last night. In announcing his plans for a stock company in Salt Lake he said the Lyceum theater, without naming it, however, had been rechristened The Bungalow. He said that it was being redecorated and that next Monday night the Willard Mack company will move to The Bungalow and enter upon a season of stock.

Mr. Mack's announcement was that arrangements had been made for a series of plays that would occupy twelve weeks and that the top price would be 75 cents for the best seats in the little playhouse. Among the plays, which will be presented are: "Heir to the Hoorah," which is next week's attraction, Kyrle Bellew's version of "Raffles," "The Holy City," "Pride of Jennico," "If I Were King," and a number of others such as the foregoing.
