

GARRICK OPENS SEPTEMBER 4.

On Sunday night, September 4, what was formerly the Grand theatre will open under the name of the Garrick. The carpenters, plasterers, steam fitters, painters and decorators have worked for the past two months and have succeeded in making of the old playhouse one of the finest and up-to-date show houses in the west; to that end thousands of dollars have been expended by the Salt Lake Amusement association, which owns and controls the Garrick. The aisles have been widened and made to comply with all requirements, new carpets have been laid covering the entire floor, new draperies are being mounted on brass rails, the draperies being of rich green plush, following out the color scheme in the interior decorations. The ceiling and walls have been decorated in the softer colors of light orange, green and gold and the effect is pleasing.

The Garrick will open the season with William Ingorsoll and his select company, presenting "Brother Officers."
