

## STATE STREET'S NEW THEATRE.

The Elite theatre, the new motion picture house to be opened this evening, will be welcomed by all lovers of motion pictures and illustrated songs. The management, in anticipation of a large crowd for their opening night, has made every possible arrangement for the accommodation of their patrons. The building formerly occupied by the Intermountain Milling company at 338 and 340 South State street has been entirely remodeled, and the result is that Salt Lake now has the proud distinction of owning one of the largest motion picture theatres in the west. The building is 100 feet long by 32 feet wide, and has a seating capacity of 600.

The program will consist of 6,000 feet of film and two illustrated songs. This will be furnished by Miles Bros. of New York and San Francisco, operating the largest film exchange in America.
