Utah Slates Premiere

Glamor in the person of blond Evelyn Keyes will reign at the world premiere showing of the Utah-made technicolor motion picture, "The Desperadoes," slated for Wednesday at 8:30 p. m. at the Utah theater.

Romantic lead in the picture opposite Glenn Ford, Miss Keyes is no stranger to Utah, having spent many weeks in Kanab filming the Columbia production. But her premiere visit will be her first to Salt Lake City, and is being made in response to an invitation from her family friend, Tracy Barham, vice president and general manager of Intermountain Theaters, Inc.

In "The Desperadoes" she plays opposite Glenn Ford and Ran-

dolph Scott, with Claire Trevor, Edgar Buchanan and Guinn "Big Boy" Williams heading the supporting cast.

Other special guests at the world premiere will be Walter Hamblin, 75-year-old Kanab rancher, who is the son of the famous Mormon Indian peacemaker, Jacob Hamblin. Mr. Hamblin was the first white child to enter Fort Kanab.
