

Granada Changes Date of Opening to Friday

The Granada theatre will open Friday evening at 7 o'clock, instead of Thursday as was previously announced.

Artists and mechanics are laboring in three shifts to complete the decorations and alterations in time for the opening.

Manager Schayer announced that changing the opening date was necessary because of a complete and thorough test being made of the acoustics and the results of the latest in sound equipment.
