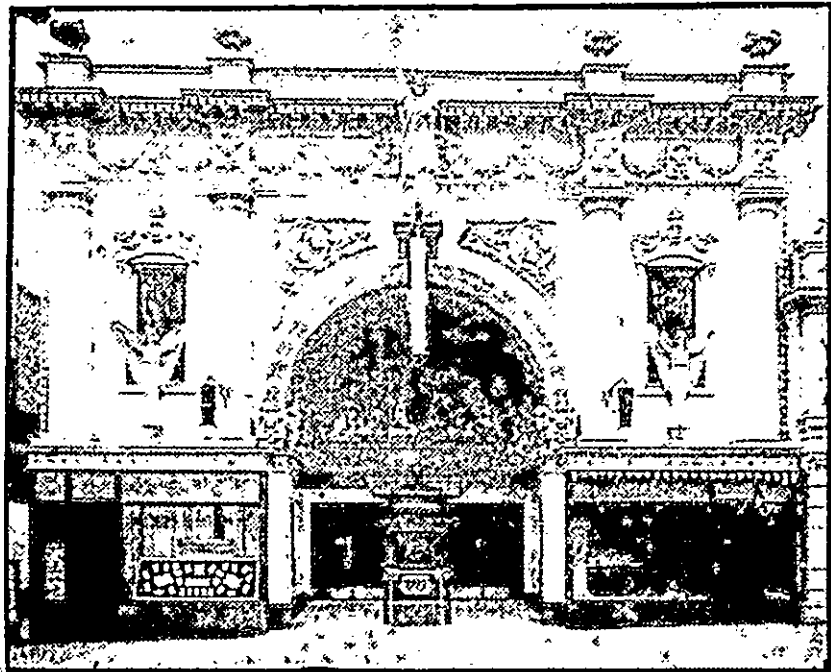


# LIBERTY THEATRE TO REOPEN TOMORROW NIGHT



The Liberty Theatre on State Street.

With a new coat of paint on the exterior, complete redecoration of the interior, several changes in the seating plan and with a new \$7000 Kimball pipe organ in place, the Liberty theatre will reopen for the season tomorrow night. The changes which have been made and the simple but effective decorations on walls and ceiling make the house one of the most modern and comfortable motion picture theatres in the west. The same policy which was in effect before the closing of the theatre will be pursued hereafter and it is the aim of the manage-

ment to offer only the best obtainable in good pictures and good music.

The Liberty will be operated in conjunction with the American theatre and new pictures will be shown at both places, changes of program being made on Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. The same orchestra which provided the music and which won such an enviable reputation prior to the closing of the house is being returned to the Liberty from the American and will be under the direction of Edgar Bayliss, who will also play the new pipe organ.

The first performance tomorrow night will commence at 7 p. m.
