

Kinema Passes to New Ownership

Louis Strike, owner of the Star theatre, and Edward Mix, former manager of the Kinema theatre, have purchased the equipment and lease of the Kinema theatre from the Universal Pictures corporation of New York City, according to Livingston Lanning of the Universal company, who is at present its manager. The two Salt Lake men will take over the picture house Saturday. Mr. Mix will serve as manager.

This theatre for the past five years has been one of the chain of picture houses owned and operated by the Universal company. The new owners, it is said, have plans whereby they will operate a chain of theatres throughout the intermountain section. The Kinema is the second showhouse to be acquired by them. The new company have made plans for redecorating. The theatre will not be closed during the work.
